

BVI Scholarship criteria

The Harneys BVI Scholarship is valued at up to US\$30,000 per academic year for a maximum period of four years. Scholarships will be awarded to talented BV Islanders/Belongers pursuing a degree at a reputable university in a subject that will allow them to pursue a career at Harneys in the British Virgin Islands. Scholarship recipients will have the opportunity to gain paid professional experience over the summer months as an intern and then join us full-time upon completion of their degree.

Scholarships will be offered for Associates and Bachelor's Degree Programs as well as for the Legal Practitioner Course (*LPC*), Professional Practice Course (*PPC*), and Graduate Diploma in Law (*GDL*) and Solicitors Qualifying Exam (*SQE*) for local or overseas studies. Scholarships will be granted on a competitive basis and proven academic and extra-curricular achievement at a high standard is a prerequisite.

Awarding of scholarship

Once the applications have been reviewed and all the required documentation has been received, shortlisted applicants will be contacted for an interview with the committee and all applicants will be contacted thereafter. Following the interview, the scholarship committee will make their decision.

Scholarship committee decisions

All decisions of the Scholarships Committee are final.
